

#### How to get to the INSA Lyon campus from Lyon Saint-Exupéry Airport

🅖 From Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport to Gare Part-Dieu

The easiest and fastest way to get to the city center from the airport is to take the Rhônexpress tramway.

Tickets are available at each Rhônexpress station or can be purchased online at <a href="https://www.rhonexpress.fr/">https://www.rhonexpress.fr/</a>.

Sales on board the tramway are not possible. During your trip, the Rhônexpress agent will ask you for your ticket for validation.

The Rhônexpress station at the airport is a 7-minutes walk from Terminals 1 and 2 and 6 minutes walk from Terminal 3.

Enter the station and take the escalators or elevators to the airport access bridge equipped with travelators. Follow the signs to reach the Rhônexpress station.

Take the Rhônexpress tramway and get off at the "Lyon Part-Dieu" station.









#### How to get to the INSA Lyon campus from Gare Part-Dieu



The TCL network (<u>www.tcl.fr/</u>) allows you to reach the INSA Lyon campus. The app or the TCL website will help you to move around the city.

The T1 and the T4 tramways connect the campus to downtown Lyon. From the Rhônexpress station "Lyon Part-Dieu", you can take the T4 to "Gare Part-Dieu Villette" or the T1 to "Gare Part-Dieu Vivier Merle" by crossing the station. The closest tramway stops to the meeting point at INSA Lyon are "INSA Einstein" (T1) and "La Doua - Gaston Berger" (T1 and T4).

Transportation is not free. Tickets can be purchased on terminals at tramway and metro stops. Inside the tramways, it is also possible to pay by credit card directly on the terminals. To do so, present your contactless bank card on the red terminal. The message "Voyage validé" will be displayed. You can travel freely on the TCL network for 1 hour by validating at each connection.

For any emergency requiring an ambulance, the fire department or the police when you are traveling in a European country. Your contact person will redirect you to the most appropriate help according to your situation.

15 - Samu

To obtain the intervention of a medical team in a situation of vital distress (malaise, coma, haemorrhage, chest pain, breathing difficulties, burns, intoxication...) or to be redirected to a permanent care organization (general medicine, ambulance transport...).

• 17 - Police

To report an offence that requires the immediate intervention of the police force (violence, assault, snatching, burglary...).

• 18 - Fire Department

To report a situation of danger or an accident involving property or people and obtain their rapid intervention.

• 114 - Emergency number for the deaf and hard of hearing

If you are a victim or witness of an emergency situation that requires the intervention of emergency services. This number is accessible by SMS, chat, video and fax.
